MERENDA REALE®

A gourmand dip in atmospheres of another time...



In 1700, the *merenda* - snacking between meals - was a royal pastime, a delicious and social ritual of life at Court, that in summer loved moving out to the welcoming country residences surrounded by huge parks: here the aristocratic *merenda* demanded only the purest chocolate, served in a cup but cold, always accompanied by subtly sweet specialities specifically invented by the Palace chefs.

In 1800, instead, in summer the biscuits were light, often based on just egg white, accompanied by a fresh, frothy zabaglione.
